\*\* Psych 199 is Supervised Independent and Research. This course is for students seeking supervised research on a psychology topic under the direction of a Psychology faculty member. Although we do not require research, we encourage students to become involved in their junior year especially those considering an Honors thesis.

\*\*\* Students who are taking honors should enroll in the Honors seminar (H194AB, optional) and Honors thesis (H195AB, required). Other students may participate in 199 or internship opportunities.

\*\*\*\*Psych 102 – Statistics for Psychological Research . It can also be taken in the senior year along with the honors seminar .
